



7 Primal Krav Maga Membership Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct should be complied with at all times as part of your membership terms and conditions. It is designed to ensure the comfort, enjoyment and the peace of mind of all members whilst maintaining the highest standard of health and safety for all members, visitors and employees. Failure to abide by this policy may result in a termination of membership

Health and Safety Culture:

All members must agree and sign a declaration of acceptance to undertake the physical Krav Maga training and must do so prior to such training.

All members must fill in a Health Questionnaire prior to training and inform the coaches of any changes in their health not stated in the aforementioned.

The instructions of the coaches must be adhered to at all times.

The use of mobile phones is not permitted whilst training has commenced. However, calls can be made and accepted if pre-agreed with the coaches.

Alcohol is not permitted and anyone suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be permitted to train.

Respect for other

Members must respect each other's well-being and take due care whilst training together.

Members must not shout, use foul, abusive language or behave in a threatening and abusive manner towards coaches, spectators and other members.

Personal cleanliness and attire

Clothing must be clean and free from odours.

Footwear must be clean and fit for purpose. (e.g. Wrestling or boxing boots).

Appropriate exercise clothing must be worn when training.

Appropriate protection must be worn, coaches discretion.

Respect for facilities and services

Respect the facilities and equipment provided for the execution of training.

Primal Krav Maga Ltd have the right to refuse memberships at their discretion if the requesting party / customer would not be in the best interest of current members.
